OCC Contract renewal has been signed for three-year extension

Ticket Load Management- John discussed how a contractor would be able to see the busy days of the week for excavating and could pick a day not so busy (OCC still collecting data)

Ticket Status Codes – SFM had an email on status code "can't gain access" or "area of excavation cannot be determined" on tickets and that status is being abused. Need more data. Policy Committee will continue to review status codes and bring back to the Board

Ticket extension pilot program – locator reaching out to the excavator asking for more time to complete the locate ticket. Need to continue gathering data, may be pushed back to Spring

o Legislature Committee (Andy Hartmann/ BJ Woehler)

BJ Woehler- discussed the LB 344 and is being reviewed by State agencies and is based around finding a solution dealing on "Improved Enforcement"

Andy Hartmann- concerns of the NDOT and their status of "exempt" from the one call system. NUCA members filled out a survey. Andy is asking to reach out to Senators to state the problems of doing work in State ROW. Having to pay to locate the utilities in State ROW is not fair. Needing to gather more data on instances happening outside the ROW
